Education and consultation for local social workers and logisticians through the transfer of knowledge and skills. The activities will contribute to the creation of long-term partnerships between organizations and communities and the building of institutional relations between Slovak subjects. Activities will strengthen solidarity and provide innovative answers to emerging social problems. The project is aimed at supporting the building of local capacities, there are not enough experts and workers in the social field in the area, and the activities of a volunteer in cooperation with an expert will lead to the education of local experts. The volunteer will work in an international team and will participate in the dissemination of knowledge and experience. The aim is to promote dialogue between cultures, strengthen solidarity and understanding between peoples and long-term partnerships between organizations and communities in Kenva. The volunteer's stay will be part of the preparation for work in the field of development cooperation. Participation in a community program for adults focused on micro-business, promotion of Slovak development aid, post-return activities will also be an important part of the project, where the valunteer will present to the Slovek public his experiences


