Description

One of the aims is also building, equipping and running medical training center in cooperation with local partners. The goals include training of medical personnel and equipping a medical training center capable of taking part in training and educating future medical professionals. This also includes compiling methodology and syllabi for future reference as well as educational standards for government agencies and departments to use. The applicant will provide direct medical and material support, especially to the marginalized groups. Direct medical intervention will alleviate the enormous demands put on local medical personnel and therefore help mitigate the adverse effects of the crisis that had spread through the region.
