Children's lessons and activities, focused on similar topics as mother's lessons, computer lessons for high school students, education aimed at preventing the spread of infectious diseases with an emphasis on the current pandemic caused by the Covid 19 virus. 2. Cooperation with Malindi District Hospital, distribution of ARV drugs for HIV+ patients, taking blood samples from patients for CD4 tests, ensuring results, leading an HIV support group - combating stigma in the community, education about the HIV virus, treatment and prevention, social and mental care for patients .
